Antarctic Conservation Act Permit Application Form (NSF Form 1078)

According to the regulations pursuant to the Antarctic Conservation Act as amended by the Antarctic Science, Tourism, and Conservation Act, a permit is required to "take" native animals or birds, engage in harmful interference, enter Antarctic Specially Protected Areas, introduce nonindigenous species into Antarctica, or import/export any antarctic fauna and flora into/from the United States.

Applicants should note that processing a permit application takes approximately 45-60 days primarily as a result of the required 30-day public comment period [Section 670.9(g)]. Questions on the Antarctic Conservation Act should be directed to:
