


# NSF Reorganization




**U.S. National Science Foundation**

# FY25 EPSCoR Highlights



4 active RII investments: E-CORE, E-RISE, FEC, and ERF

RII Track-1 awards continue to be phased out



8 EPSCoR Live! events hosted

A mix of program webinars and critical topics for EPSCoR jurors.



120 awards co-funded with other NSF Directorates and Offices

\$33.5M from EPSCoR, for a total NSF investment of \$107.4M



20.5% of NSF funding went to EPSCoR jurisdictions

Well above the 16.5% benchmark in CHIPS & Science



3 Workshops awarded

Topics ranged across data science, fluid mechanics, and microplastics in coastal ecosystems.
