SUBJECT: FAR Class Deviation for FAR Part 45 in Support of Executive Order 14275 on

Restoring Common Sense to Federal Procurement

PURPOSE: This memorandum approves a class deviation to Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) part 45 for purposes of implementing the Federal Acquisition Regulatory Council's (the Council's) model deviation text to FAR Part 45.

BACKGROUND: Executive Order (E.O.) 14275 on Restoring Common Sense to Federal Procurement, signed on April 15, 2025, mandates a comprehensive review and simplification of the FAR.

The FAR is being updated to:

- Remove language that is not required by statute
- Remove duplicative or outdated language
- Clarify or provide more plain language
- Align with the new FAR framework
- Preserve essential governmentwide acquisition standards.

This project is referred to as the Revolutionary FAR Overhaul (RFO) initiative.

SUMMARY OF CHANGES: FAR part 45, Government Property, has been retained with minimal deletions and minor updates made for plain language. No changes were made to

provisions or clauses. The FAR Companion includes additional guidance and best practices to support this FAR part.

Statutory requirements and presidential directives retained in the RFO FAR part 45 model deviation include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 40 U.S.C. § 503, Exchange or Sale of Similar Items
- 40 U.S.C. § 524, Duties of Executive Agencies
- 40 U.S.C. § 546, Contractor Inventories

APPLICABILITY: This class deviation applies to all NSF procurement actions.

AUTHORITY: This class deviation is issued under the authority of EO 14275, <u>OMB Memo M-25-26</u>, 48 CFR 1.4, and RFO FAR 1.304.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This deviation is effective on the date of this letter and shall remain in effect until it is incorporated into the FAR, or until this class deviation is rescinded, extended, or amended.
