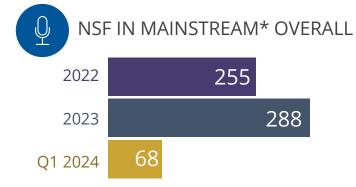




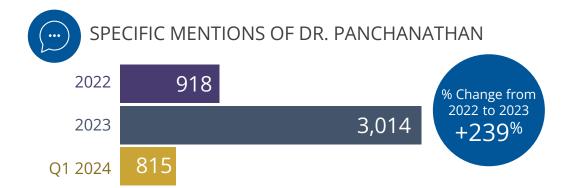

Include "U.S." in the agency name when written in full.

U.S. National Science Foundation

Logos, policy information and other resources are in the NSF Brand Identity Portal.

Ensure you are using the most recent logo files.

Updates to signage posted on physical property such as facilities, centers, buildings, equipment, vehicles, etc. should be completed by Dec 31, 2024.

Webpages and other high-profile communications should also be updated to align with the brand standards.

GRANT TERMS AND CONDITIONS HAVE BEEN UPDATED TO REFLECT ALIGNMENT WITH THE BRAND POLICY.

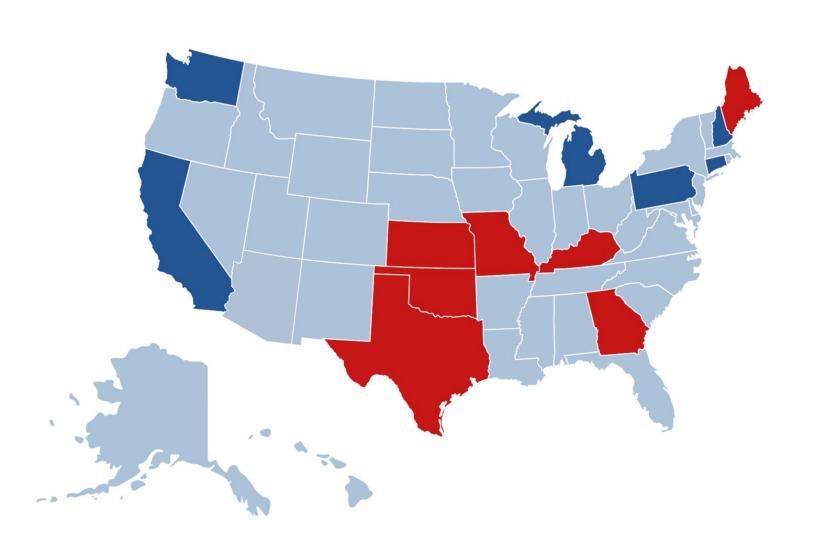

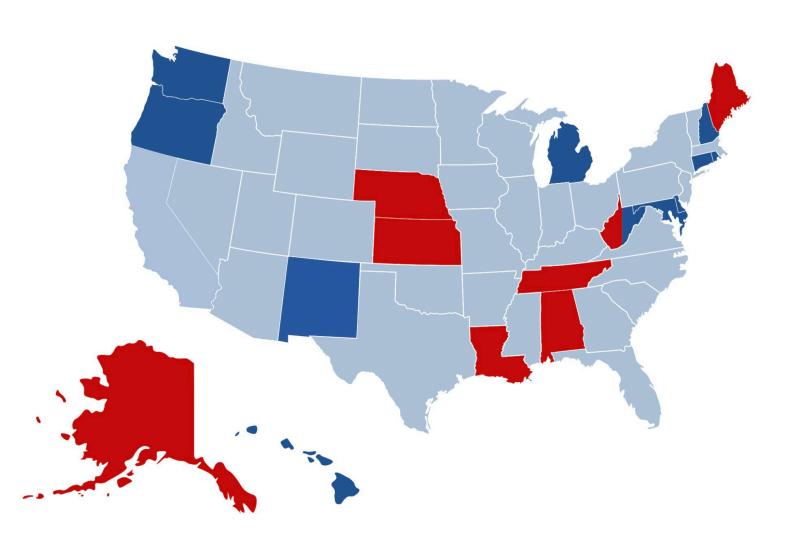
