

Transportation and Logistics



U.S. ANTARCTIC PROGRAM

Through various partnerships, USAP transports people and cargo to and from Antarctica, as well as throughout the continent.

Population/Flights



2,500 passengers each year move between Christchurch and NSF McMurdo Station.



~400 passengers each summer move between NSF McMurdo Station and NSF South Pole.



Winter flights to/from NSF McMurdo Station occur each August (3-5 missions). March-September is considered Winter and there are no planned flights in and out of the NSF South Pole during that time... and very few in/out of NSF McMurdo Station.



Summer "season" starts in October and runs through February each year.

Traverse



3 trips to South Pole per summer season delivering about **140-170K gallons of fuel/trip**.

Cargo



Ice pier is used for vessel operations at NSF McMurdo Station.



2.5M lbs/year between Christchurch and NSF McMurdo Station.



1.8M lbs/year of cargo moves via commercial air/commercial surface from Port Hueneme to Christchurch.



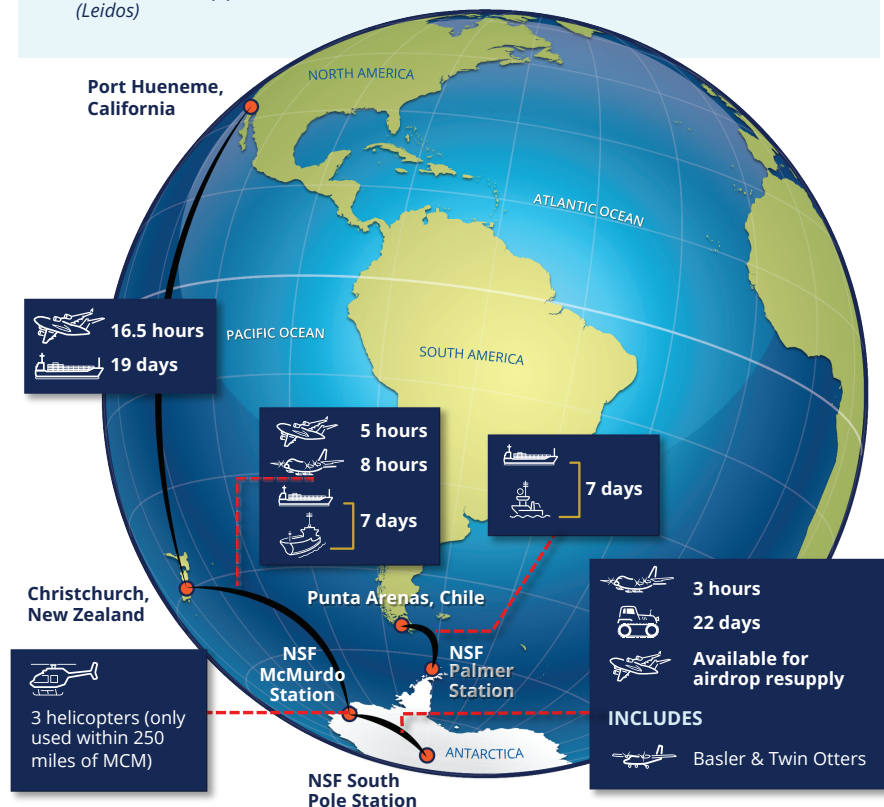
Avg ~9M lbs/year offloaded at NSF McMurdo Station.



2 runways are used for airlift at NSF McMurdo Station – Phoenix and Williams (ski aircraft only at Williams) airfields, Phoenix is maintained to be operational year-round, if needed.
