The National Science Foundation (NSF) has completed the review and resolution of the NSF Office of Inspector General (NSF OIG) audit report on costs incurred under NSF's Industry-University Cooperative Research Center: Center for Advance Forestry Systems (IUCRC CAFS) award to University of Georgia dated November 19, 2024.
