Dear Christopher Boynton,

The National Science Foundation (NSF) has completed the review and resolution of the Office of Inspector General (NSF OIG) audit report on costs incurred under the Center for Advance Forestry Systems (CAFS) awards by University of Maine (UMaine) dated January 21, 2025.

The audit report questioned \$12,282 in costs claimed under NSF awards and recommended that UMaine strengthen its administrative and management controls for the areas in which findings were identified. As a result of its resolution efforts, NSF has determined that \$12,282 will be disallowed. The table below summarizes the resolution of each finding by recommendation:
