Dear Susan Zipkin and Louise Griffin,

The National Science Foundation (NSF) has completed the review and resolution of the Office of Inspector General (NSF OIG) audit report on costs incurred under NSF awards by the University of New Hampshire (UNH) dated January 26, 2024.

The audit report questioned a total of \$7,754 in costs claimed under NSF awards and recommended that UNH strengthen its administrative and management controls for the areas in which findings were identified. As a result of its resolution efforts, NSF has determined that \$4,604 will be disallowed. The table below summarizes the resolution of each finding by recommendation:
