The National Science Foundation (NSF) has completed the review and resolution of the Office of Inspector General (OIG) audit report, on costs incurred under NSF awards by Monterey Bay Aquarium Research Institute (MBARI), dated August 4, 2023.

The audit report identified a total of \$2,981.00 in questioned costs claimed on NSF awards and recommended that MBARI strengthen its administrative and management controls, over the areas in which the findings and questioned costs were identified. As a result of its resolution efforts, NSF determined \$2,891.00, will be sustained. The table below summarizes the sustained, allowed, and disallowed costs by the finding number:
