Dear David M. Laffey:

The National Science Foundation (NSF) has completed the review and resolution of the NSF Office of Inspector General (NSF OIG) audit report on costs incurred under NSF's Center for Space, High-Performance, and Resilient Computing (SHREC) award to the University of Pittsburgh dated May 10, 2024.

The audit report questioned \$1,350 in costs claimed under NSF's SHREC award and recommended that PITT IUCRC-SHREC strengthen its administrative and management controls for the area in which findings were identified. As a result of its resolution efforts, NSF determined \$1,350 will be disallowed. The following table summarizes the resolution of each finding by recommendation:
