The National Science Foundation (NSF) has completed the review and resolution of the NSF Office of Inspector General (NSF OIG) audit report on costs incurred under the Center for Advanced Forestry Systems (CAFS) awards by North Carolina State University (NC State) dated September 30, 2024.

The audit report questioned \$0 claimed under NSF awards and recommended that NC State strengthen its administrative and management controls for the areas in which findings were identified. As a result of its resolution efforts, NSF sustains all the findings and recommendations. The table below summarizes the resolution of each finding by recommendation:
