REVISION OF THE NATIONAL SCIENCE FOUNDATION (NSF) SMALL BUSINESS INNOVATION RESEARCH (SBIR)/SMALL BUSINESS TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER (STTR) PHASE I GRANT GENERAL CONDITIONS (SBIR-I)

EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 1, 2012

Effective February 1, 2012, new NSF SBIR/STTR Phase I grants and funding amendments to existing NSF SBIR/STTR Phase I grants will begin referencing and are subject to the *NSF SBIR/STTR Phase I Grant General Conditions* (SBIR-I) dated 02/12. The complete text of the SBIR-I conditions (as well as other NSF grant policy issuances) is available electronically on the NSF website.¹

Except as noted in a specific article, the *NSF SBIR/STTR Phase I Grant General Conditions* apply to all new NSF SBIR/STTR Phase I grants and funding increments on existing NSF SBIR/STTR Phase I grants awarded on or after February 1, 2012.

- Grantee Responsibilities, Article 2, has been supplemented with a weblink to a listing
 of the National Policy Requirements.
- Patent Rights, Article 19, has a footnote added to it stating that, while the Article remains unchanged at this time, NSF is assessing how best to implement revisions given the Stanford vs. Roche Supreme Court decision.
